What Happens Next?

- Start enjoying the club facilities and get your handicap rounds completed (we need 3 x 18 holes to get you started)
- You will be contacted soon* by a member of the match committee who will invite you to your Induction Meeting** which takes about 40 minutes
- Attend the short induction meeting familiarise yourself with how we work, how to book in, how to enter your card and a few of the local rules etc
- Play relaxed competition golf and enjoy yourself – The Council own the course so we still pay green fees, but as a member of BPGC, we are eligible for approximately 30% off the usual green fees for both competition and social play (e.g. 18 hole Adults \$21.5 VS \$32.60 & for pensioners \$16 VS \$21 - junior and student discounts also apply). Note: When playing in Club competitions, we pay a comp fee to the Club of \$6.50. This pool covers the prizes on the day***. For example, up to \$40 in Club vouchers for individual winners, same for the team game, and up to \$12 for nearest the pin or the drive and chip.
- Our Competition tee times on the course are below. Saturday & Sunday are block times reserved for members and their guests only:
 - Saturdays: Ladies' and Men's competitions
 - Summer 6:00am – 10:30am
 - Winter 7:00am – 11:30am
 - Sundays: Medley competition
 - 9:00am – 10:30am (earlier times can be booked via the Pro Shop ONLY)
 - Wednesday: Ladies' competition
 - Summer 8.30am – 10:00am
 - Winter 9:00am – 10:30am
 - Fridays: Medley Competition
 - First Light – 1:00pm
- You can book your tee time via our website using your phone or computer, or via the computer in the Arthur Collins Room at the Club. Following your induction, you will be issued your user name and password
- Every Friday night at 6:15pm in the Club, we have a draw for Saturday tee times (two weeks in advance). The booking sheets are opened here first before they become available on the website on Saturday morning. After the draw we have meat raffles, a pick a card draw, and a drink tab draw - we recommend you come down to the Club on Friday evenings if you are looking for an early tee time.

If you need to get an official GA Handicap, talk to one of our team, or the Pro shop, to book a time to play with a member to get your card signed – you need to submit 3 x 18 hole or 6 x 9 hole cards (or combination of) from BPGC that are signed by a member to submit and obtain your official Golf Australia handicap. Once you have that, you are ready to compete in the competitions.

* after the required 7 days the application must be displayed on our notice board

** A simple induction meeting with one of our team where you will be given your fixture book, and we will explain the basic details of club membership, how things work, competitions, tee time booking, website access, membership card and bar credits etc
